Reduced-price season tickets

Family Quotient under or equal to €795
You qualify for a reduced-price season ticket.

The Eurometropolis of Strasbourg's **solidarity fare system** offers passengers the **possibility of reduced-price season tickets**. Prices depend on passenger **age**, their **Family Quotient (FQ)** or, for students, the **amount of their grant**. The reduction is valid for a maximum period of 12 months and can be renewed.



Did you know?

The Family Quotient is the calculation of a household's resources compared to the number of people in it as well as their income. Only those people included on the document can qualify for the reduced-price fares.

(2) PRM: Person with Reduced Mobility, in possession of a CMI 80% disability card or an MDPH 80% disability card, or holders of a war pensioner disability card with a double blue bar (disability requiring assistance from a third party) or a double red bar (disability ≥ 85% or ≥ 60% if war-wounded).
